Agenda item:

Christian Knight attended from the City of Kirkland to provide an update on capital projects, and to raise awareness of the Neighborhood Safety Program

Discussion Notes:

- Mr. Knight provided an update on the following topics:
- Juanita Drive safety plan, including:
 - Sidewalk widening right before Juanita Bay
 - Painting a “bike box” at the Juanita intersection
 - Discussion with attendees on modal prioritization (e.g. bikes, cars, pedestrians)
- City plan to install a beacon crosswalk at 4th and Market to be installed in Summer 2017
- City regulation change to establish a \$45 fine for parking in bike lanes; courtesy period before fines will be levied
- **Neighborhood safety projects**
- Three criteria for a Neighborhood Safety Project to be considered for City funding:
 - Improve safety
 - Neighborhood support
 - \$50k or less
