7:00 PM – Introductions: Neighbors and MNA attending board members

7:05 PM – **New Boating Ordinance**, Lt. John Haslip – Operations Division, KPD

- Since ordinance passed in July, 3 citations issued, with many warnings given
- Residents feel as if it has largely made a difference to the noise levels
- Expect continued progress next summer

7:10 PM – **Recent incidences**, Audra Weber – Neighborhood Resource Officer, KPD

- Reports of shots fired in early Tuesday morning near Heritage Park
- 2 officers searched for an hour, but found nothing

7:20 PM – **Prop 1, Levy for city street maintenance, restoration, enhancement**, Ray Steiger- Public Works Director

- Pavement Conditions Index (PCI) ranges from 0 – 100; overall goal for arterials is 70, but currently at 59
- Prop 1 would be an ongoing tax of 20.4 cents per \$1000 of assessed property value, raising approximately \$3 million per year
- \$2.7 of \$3 million expected to spent on streets, remainder on pedestrian safety (crosswalks, wheelchair ramps, etc.) and safe routes to schools (sidewalks)

7:40 PM – **Prop 2, Levy for city parks maintenance, restoration, enhancement**, Jennifer Schroeder-Director of Parks Dept.

- Economic downturn still impacting ability to properly maintain parks, restrooms, trash collections and consistent life guard services
- Prop 2 would be an ongoing tax of 16.0 cents per \$1000 of assessed property value, raising approximately \$2.35 million per year
- Over time, \$1.1 million to be spent on park maintenance (restore previous reductions, maintain OO Denny Park, Cross-Kirkland Corridor), \$800k for dock and shoreline renovations, \$1 million on city-school district playfields partnership, \$1.2 million on Juanita Beach bathhouse replacement, \$1 million on Edith Moulton Park Renovation, \$500k on Waverly Beak Park Renovation, \$1.6 million on Cross-Kirkland Corridor Trail, \$2.5 million on Open Space and Park Land Acquisition
